Important Notice!

For the past few weeks we have been under a grace period, but Waste Management will begin strictly adhering to their contract the second week of July and thereafter. Only what is inside the WM issued cart will be picked up. Make sure the bin wheels face your house and is not too close to your mailbox. In addition, if the lid is lifted up, it will not be picked it up, per WM. Please use an alternative bin for your recyclables and place on the opposite side of your driveway, which will be picked up by a separate truck. Violators will be issued a warning by WM.




Please don't forget to keep your pets on leash, in addition to picking up after them. (You will find Oakwood's leash and pooper scooper laws in our codified section 505.18)

Paper Recycling in Jeopardy



River Valley Paper Company

Over the past several years, the Village has partnered with River Valley Paper Company to offer a simple way to recycle paper, using the bin located near the Sandwich Shop at the intersection of Pettibone and Broadway. The paper and cardboard is recycled and a small stipend funds the Hawthorne Valley Youth Council program.

Unfortunately, with the fall of recycling prices, River Valley can no longer support a paper recycling bin which does not recycle at least two ton per month. We have been collecting less than the minimum for some time. For this reason, the bin is in jeopardy of being pulled. If this happens, please recycle paper in your curbside recycling.

The Oakwood Police Dept. has implemented a safe place to transact business at Village Hall. Multiple cameras catch all movement, which



may help residents feel safer when meeting for this purpose.
