Piles that contain items other than leaves WILL NOT be picked up. If you have branches or brush, you may tie them into small bundles no more than 4-feet long for regular Monday trash pick up. Do not place leaves in the roadway. The Service Department will make recurring trips around the Village until the weather becomes inclement.
